# **Patriot Military Family Foundation Impact**



### **Veteran Health**

The PTS program started in Chicago with Dr. Eugene Lipov, a pain management specialist, and his treatment, Stellate Ganglion Block (SGB), has a 70% success rate in relieving PTS symptoms for combat veterans since 2008.



## **Scholarships**

PMFF offers scholarships for veterans' children in collaboration with organizations like Joint Special Operations Command and Night Stalkers. Scholarships are provided through entities such as the Navy Seal Foundation, Ranger Scholarship Fund, All Ranks Association, and Special Forces Scholarship Fund.



## **Veteran Support**

PMFF collaborates with the USO of North Carolina in various veteran support programs and raises funds to support veterans throughout North Carolina. They also provide support to veterans at organizations such as Lords Harvest, Operation North State, and the Community Culinary School.



#### **Veteran Homes**

We work with Purple Heart Homes, Charlotte Bridge Home, and Hearts and Hammers to build affordable homes in NC for service-disabled veterans and their families. The first home was built in 2014, and the program will continue to provide homes for as long as lots are available.



## **Family Support**

We provide assistance and support to families of fallen veterans, and offer Reconnect weekends for returning combat veterans and their families in a fun and relaxing environment, reducing the high divorce rate among returning veterans. Last year we gave Christmas gifts to families in need. We have provided Christmas gifts to 59 families, including over 150 family members.



## **Veteran Service Dogs**

PMFF has partnered with Saving Grace K9s and All Aspects to provide service animals to service-disabled veterans, particularly those suffering from PTS or TBI. So far, the foundation has provided 69 veterans with service animals.
